CREDIT APPROVAL - Credit will be extended to you based on our evaluation of your financial condition, and credit will continue to be extended only if you remain current. We may withdraw or modify credit privileges at any time. If you are a tenant, you hereby assume the tank lease for the tank located at the address provided in the credit application. If you are a tenant, in the event of a default in payment, you consent to us informing your landlord of the default and the cessation of providing liquid feed and equipment to the address provided in the credit application, pursuant to applicable law. If you are a landlord, you guarantee the obligations of the tenant to us under the credit application and this credit policy. All parties signing the Application shall be jointly and severally liable for any and all obligations incurred or credit extended.

STATEMENTS - A statement will be generated at each month end and will include all purchases for that month, plus any unpaid balance carried forward from the previous statement and accrued finance charges. Accounts not paid in full within twenty-eight (28) days following the original statement date will be considered past due.

Notify Us in Case of Errors or Questions about Your Bill
 If you think your bill is wrong, or if you need more information about a transaction on your bill, write us (on a separate sheet) at the address listed on your bill. Write to us as soon as possible. We must hear from you no later than 60 days after we sent you the first bill on which the error or problem appeared. You can telephone us, but doing so will not preserve your rights.

In your letter, give us the following information:
 • Your name and account number.
 • The dollar amount of the suspected error.
 • Describe the error and explain, if you can, why you believe there is an error. If you need more information, describe the item you are not sure about.

Your Rights and Our Responsibilities After We Receive Your Written Notice
 We must acknowledge your letter within 30 days, unless we have corrected the error by then. Within 90 days, we must either correct the error or explain why we believe the bill was correct. After we receive your letter, we cannot try to collect any amount you question, or report you as delinquent. We can continue to bill you for the amount you question, including finance charges, and we can apply any unpaid amount against your credit limit. You do not have to pay any questioned amount while we are investigating, but you are still obligated to pay the parts of your bill that are not in question. If we find that we made a mistake on your bill, you will not have to pay any finance charges related to any questioned amount. If we did not make a mistake, you may have to pay finance charges, and you will have to make up any missed payments on the questioned amount. In either case, we will send you a statement of the amount you owe and the date that it is due. If you fail to pay the amount that we think you owe, we may report you as delinquent. However, if our explanation does not satisfy you and you write to us within 10 days telling us that you still refuse to pay, we must tell anyone we report you to that you have a question about your bill.
